

- 5. Class conflicts may occur. Please schedule carefully. No refunds for missed classes. Refunds for classes will be given only in case of accident or illness to the terrier or owner, or for bitches in heat.
- 6. Dogs must be leashed or crated at all times.
- 7. No puppies under three months of age permitted on the grounds. This includes the camping area. Anyone violating trial rules will be excused from all classes and asked to leave the trial site; no refunds.
- 8. No puppy sales are permitted on the trial site.
- 9. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated at any time during the trial. Anyone demonstrating poor sportsmanship will be dismissed from the grounds.

DIVISION A: RACING

- All terriers, including 4-6 month puppies, must be muzzled for racing.
- Basket muzzles preferred. No open-ended muzzles. No colored muzzles except white, back, tan, and clear. No
- Baskerville muzzles.
- Collars should be off when on deck.
- All terriers entering the catch area during a race without a secured muzzle will be disqualified.
- No request for height measurement once racing has begun.
- Terriers May Not cross-enter between Adult, Veteran and Senior Classes.

Qualifications for Championship Run Offs

- 1) A terrier MUST ENTER AN FINISH in both, at least one flat race AND one hurdle race at the beginning level based on trial entries (heat, semi, final)
- 2) A FINISHED race is when the terrier runs down the track unassisted (by owner or anyone else) with a secured muzzle to the backside of the barrier
- 3) Terrier must place first in a flat or hurdle final to qualify for championship run offs. First to the hole is not necessarily first through the backside of the barrier
- 4) In the event a terrier does not meet all the above criteria, the second-place terrier in the final of that class (either flats or hurdles will qualify for the championship run off if they meet the criteria as outlined above.

Division B - CONFORMATION

- Cross entering is not permitted within or between the Open and Working sections.
- Exhibitors participating in the working classes <u>must submit the appropriate JRTCA paperwork with entries.</u> The judge may require a copy of the National Hunting Certificate to be presented to the ring steward at the time of judging.
- Registered terriers may submit a copy of the NHC application signed by a JRTCA working judge, within 30 days of the date it was issued.
- Spayed or neutered terriers may only compete in miscellaneous conformation classes.

DIVISION C: GO-TO-GROUND – All Open and Championship classes are allowed 1 second per Foot of tunnel to reach quarry.

- Class 91 **Pre-Novice Puppy.** Open to Jack Russell puppies 4 up to 6 months. Entry in Pre-Novice Puppy class does not affect the puppy's eligibility to enter the Novice Class after 6 months of age. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter until quarry is reached; mark quarry for 15 seconds without a break in work and without leaving quarry.
- Class 92 **Novice Puppy.** Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have not scored a 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open Puppy Class at this trial. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; when quarry is reached must work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without a beak in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another (examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.)
- Class 93 Open Puppy. Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have scored a 100% in a Novice Go-to-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. Not open to any puppy which has competed in Puppy Championship GTG. Puppies earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Puppy Championship GTG class at this trial or may continue competing in Open Puppy GTG class at future trials. 1 second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.)
- Class 94 **Novice Adult.** Open to Jack Russells one year of age or older which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open class at this trial. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another (examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying)
- Class 95 **Open Adult.** Open to Jack Russells one year or older which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-to-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. 1 second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.) May continue to compete in Open Adult class until they apply for a receive their Trial Certificate. A terrier achieving 100% in the Open Adult Class is eligible to apply for a Trial Certificate when terrier is registered or recorded with the JRTCA.
- Class 96 **Puppy Championship.** Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have earned 100% in an Open Go-to-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. A copy of a 100% Open score sheet shall be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den

Steward at the time of class. First and second place winners will be Puppy Go-to---Ground Champion and Reserve. (1 second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before the quarry is reached; when quarry is reached must work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.) Once a puppy competes in Puppy Championship GTG, they cannot return to open.

- Class 97 **10" up to 12½" Championship Certificate.** Open to any adult Jack Russell 10 up to 12½" one year and over, which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of class. First and second place winners will be Go-to-Ground Champion and Reserve. 1 second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)
- Class 98

 12½" up to 15" Championship Certificate. Open to any adult Jack Russell over 12½" up to 15" one year and over, which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Go-to-Ground Champion and Reserve. (1 second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)
- Veteran Certificate 10" up to 12½". Open to any adult Jack Russell 6 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES. (1 second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)
- Veteran Certificate 12½" up to 15". Open to any adult Jack Russell 6 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES. (1 second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)
- Class 101 Senior Certificate 10" up to 12½". Open to any adult Jack Russell 9 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES. (1 second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)
- Class 102 Senior Certificate 12½" up to 15". Open to any adult Jack Russell 9 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES. (1 second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)
- Class 103 Other Earthdog Non-Sanctioned. Open to any Earthdog other than a Jack Russell Terrier. (1 second per 1 foot of tunnel. Puppies can leave and re-enter several times until quarry is reached, adults cannot; work quarry for 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)

DIVISION D: SUPER EARTH

- Class 104 **6 up to 12-month Open Puppy Super Earth.** Puppies receiving a 100% score in this class at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee enter the Puppy Championship class at this trial OR <u>may continue competing in the Open Puppy SE Class at future trials.</u>
- Class 105 **10" up to 12½" Open Adult Super Earth**. Open to terriers one year and older. May continue to compete in Open Adult class until they apply for and receive their Trial Certificate. A terrier achieving 100% in the open adult class is eligible to apply for a Trial Certificate when terrier is registered or recorded with the JRTCA. This applies to Veterans and Seniors also.
- Class 106 12½" up to 15" Open Adult Super Earth. Open to terriers one year and older.
- Class 107 10" up to 12½" Open Veteran Super Earth. Open to terriers six years and older.
- Class 108 12½" up to 15" Open Veterans Super Earth. Open to terriers six years and older.
- Class 109 **6 up to 12-month Puppy Champion Super Earth.** Open to 6 up to 12-month JRT puppies which have earned 100% in an Open 6 up to 12-month Puppy Supper Earth Class at this or a previous JRTCA Trial. A copy of a 100% score sheet must be presented with pre-entry or be shown to den steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Puppy Super Earth Champion and Reserve. Once a puppy competes in Puppy Championship SE they cannot return to Open.
- 10" up to 12½" Adult Certificate Super Earth. Open to Jack Russell Terriers, one year and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be the 10" up to 12½" Adult Certificate Super Earth Champion and Reserve.
- Class 111 12½" up to 15" Adult Certificate Super Earth. Open to Jack Russell Terriers, one year and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be the 12½" up to 15" Adult Certificate Super Earth Champion and Reserve
- Class 112 **10" up to 12½" Veteran Certificate Super Earth.** Open to 10" up to 12½" Jack Russell Terriers, six years and older which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with the pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Veteran Super Earth Champion and Reserve.
- Class 113 **12½" up to 15" Veteran Certificate Super Earth.** Open to 12½" up to 15" Jack Russell Terriers, six years and older which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with the pre-entry or be shown to the Den

Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Veteran Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

- Class 114 **10" up to 12½" Senior Certificate Super Earth.** Open to 10" up to 12½" Jack Russell Terriers nine years and older which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with the pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Senior Super Earth Champion and Reserve.
- Class 115 **12½" up to 15" Senior Certificate Super Earth.** Open to 12½" up to 15" Jack Russell Terriers, nine years and older which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with the pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Senior Super Earth Champion and Reserve
- Class 116 Other Earthdog Non-Sanctioned. Open to any Earthdog other than a Jack Russell Terrier

DIVISION E: TRAILING AND LOCATING. An enclosed area of brush and other obstacles where the game is for the terrier to find the rat in the fastest time.

- 1. The handler must remain at the starting area.
- 2. No directional hand signals allowed.
- 3. The handler may use verbal commands to praise or recall the terrier.
- 4. The length of the course is a minimum of 50 steps with at least two, but not more than four, changes in direction.
- 5. The trail is scented before the competition, at least 30 minutes prior to the competition for the scent to dry to the vegetation and the ground. The preferable scent is a mixture of fox urine, water and unscented glycerin.
- 6. No schooling is permitted in area prior to the competition starting.
- 7. Flags are not to be used to mark the course.
- 8. The terrier is judged on his ability to follow a line in a simulated natural hunting environment, to locate, mark and open on the quarry.
- 9. The terrier is judged on a combination of time and accuracy. The terrier with the fastest time is not necessarily the winner.
- 10. The starting point is a natural marked spot indicated by the Judge.
- 11. The end is a natural marked spot approximately 2-3 feet from the actual quarry. The terrier's time is clocked up until he comes to this spot. This is considered coming up to the quarry for this test.
- 12. Additions of 1-15 seconds are taken for the following:
 - Backtracking: Runs back over the line/scented trail.
 - Overrunning: Overruns the line at a sharp turn; the harder the drive, the more the correction has to be made.
 - Weaving: Runs from side to side of the line.
 - Swinging: Races in wide circles in hit or miss fashion. Does not follow line directly. Skirts cover, sloppy work.

- Pottering/Loafing: Mucking about on line, goes over line again. Makes check/ change of direction where none exists. Lacks animation. Swings off line at start of check, then waits for someone to find line. Pees on bushes, pokes in holes, wastes time.
- Babbling: Opens/barks inappropriately off the line or on other game.
- Quitting: Should be taken off trail and disqualified. Handler Error: Misleads or distracts terrier. Does not follow orders/rules.
- Switching Quarry: Dog swings off line completely. Dog runs other quarry/trail.
- 13. Deductions of 1-15 points are taken for the following:
 - Marking Quarry: Should come up to quarry: points off for not going the whole way.
- 14. BONUS: 10 seconds off time if dog opens on quarry.
- Class 117 Puppies up to 12 months.
- Class 118 Adults 1 year and older 10" up to 12½"
- Class 119 Adults 1 year and over 12½" up to 15"
- Class 120 Veterans, 6 years and older.
- Class 121 Seniors 9 years and older.
- Class 122 High Point and Reserve High Point is the best time of the day with the least amount of deductions. Reserve High Point is the reserve best time of the day with the least amount of deductions.

DIVISION F: AGILITY

(Absolutely no flexi-leads, no racing leads, martingale collars or harnesses)

Class 123 Agility III, Off-Lead

Time 3.00 + 10% Veterans classes - Add 10% more course time and may jump 8" or 12", as desired by exhibitor. All "under" terriers have the option to jump 8". Course run off-lead only. The course length is 15 to 20 obstacles. Use of the A-frame, dog walk, teeter, open tunnels, collapsible tunnel, tire jump, winged and non-winged jumps ,12 weave poles and the tire jump, when possible. The course ends in a "Gamble". The "gamble" is to be 3 or 4 obstacles- made up of jumps and tunnels, only. The "Gamble" line is to be placed 8 to 10 inches from the center of all obstacles. The "Gamble" line is not to exceed 10 feet from the center of any given jump in the Gamble. Terriers may not be cross entered into Class 155.

Class 124 Agility, On-Lead

(Absolutely no flexi-leads, no racing leads, martingale collars or harnesses.) Time 1.5yps. Open to any adult terrier which has not scored above 190 points in a previous Agility class. This class is for the true beginner terrier and fosters the intent for the terrier to have a pleasant experience on the basic agility equipment. Handlers who drag the terrier during the course, will be seriously faulted. Course to be run – on lead, only. Course to include-A-frame set at 4'6", dog walk, open tunnels, Collapsible tunnels, winged and non-winged jumps. Tire jump and teeter will not be used. The course length is 12 to 15 obstacles. ** Although this class is for the beginner, it is best for the terrier to have prior exposure to agility equipment.) Class

Class 125 Agility I, off-lead

Time 1.75yps. All under dogs can jump 8", if the handler chooses. 3 qualifying scores will earn an Agility I Certificate. After earning the certificate, the handler/terrier team, may remain in this class. No cross entering allowed into Agility II or Agility III. Terriers entered into Agility II or Agility III are NOT eligible to compete in this class. Course is run" off-lead" only. The course length is 12 to 15 obstacles- A-frame set @ 4'6", dog walk, open tunnels, collapsible tunnels, tire jump, winged jumps, non-winged jumps, and 6 weave poles. (Course design should include on discrimination or change of direction.) No tire jump or teeter to be used.

Class 126 Agility II, off-lead

Time 2.25 yps + 10% Veteran classes - Add 10% more course time and may jump8". All "under" terriers have the option of jumping8". Course is to be run off-lead only. A more difficult course is set- to include all of Agility I equipment plus 2 more hurdles, weave poles and teeter. The course length is 15 to 17 obstacles. A-frame, dog walk, teeter, open tunnels, collapsible tunnels, tire jump, winged jumps, non-winged jumps and 6 weave poles.

Class 127 Games- off lead. SATURDAY ONLY – TUNNELERS

Tunnelers- A series of 13 to 15 obstacles- consisting of only tunnels. This class tests the ingenuity of the handler and distance ability of the terrier; any and all patterns are possible. (Offered on Saturday, only)

Class 128 Games- off Lead. SUNDAY ONLY- JUMPERS

Jumpers - Time 2.75yps + 10% more course time and may jump 8". If a leash is used during competitive run, a 5-point fault will be tallied. The course length is 12 to 17 obstacles. Jumps as well as tunnels may be used and at least 1 lead change is observed. Scoring is time plus faults, with the lowest score achieving 1st place, regardless of the number of faults. 5 faults for running the course on lead, 5 faults for knocking the bar and 5 faults for going off course. 15 faults for missed obstacles. Use of open tunnels, collapsible tunnels, winged jumps, non-winged jumps, single jumps as well as double jumps only. The collapsible tunnel is to be used at the end of the course only. (Offered on Sunday, only)

** Please use score sheet to apply for Jumpers/Games Certificate. JRTCA requires 3 of either Jumpers/Games with no faults. May be mixed (either Jumpers or Tunnelers) for qualifying scores.

NOTE: The dogs with the 2 highest combined scores from classes 123, 1243, 125, and 126 will be the Agility Trial Champion and Reserve.

DIVISION G: LURE COURSING (NON-SANCTIONED)

This is a timed event with terrier chasing the lure. Fastest time of the two runs qualifies for ribbons 1st-6th. Championship ties will be broken by the terrier's second lure coursing time.

Class 129 Puppies 6-12 months 10" up to 121/2"

Class 130 Puppies 6-12 months over 12½" up to 15"

Class 131	Just for Fun Dogs/Bitches under 10" May not cross enter.
Class 132	Adults 1 year and older, 10" up to 12½"
Class 133	Adults 1 year and older, over 12½" up to 15"
Class 134	Veterans 6 years and older, 10" up to 12½"

Class 136	Seniors 9 years and older, 10" up to 12½"

Class 139	10" up to 12½" Lure Coursing Champion and Reserve - fastest

Class 140	Over 12½" up to 15" Over Lure Coursing Champion and Reserve - fastest times of the day.

DIVISION H: BRUSH HUNT (NON-SANCTIONED)

- Can your terrier find the quarry?
- > Time starts when the handler releases the terrier in the brush area.
- > After one minute, handler may assist the terrier in locating the quarry.
- > JUDGE determines when the terrier locates and or works the quarry.

DIVISION I – TNT TUNNEL ADVENTURE

This is a timed event/competition with the terrier working its way through a tunnel maze that may have dead ends and obstacles to maneuver. The tunnel has a clear side so you can see the progress of your terrier as it makes its way to the caged quarry. The terrier runs the tunnel twice; the best time is the final time that counts towards placement.

Class 150 Puppies, 4 months up to 12 months.

Class 151 Adults up to 6 years

Class 152 Veterans 6+ years

Class 153 Seniors 9+ years

Class 154 TNT Champion and Reserve will be determined by 1st and 2nd fastest times of the day.

DIVISION J - BALL TOSS - SATURDAY ONLY - 1:00 to 3:30

Ball toss is a timed event. Three (3) tosses with the best time recorded. Ball is tossed a specific distance; dog must retrieve the ball back over the start/finish line with each toss/retrieval timed. A variety of balls will be provided, or you may use your dog's "favorite" ball.

Class 156	Adult, 1 year and older, up to 12 ½"
Class 157	Adult, 1 year and older, Over 12 ½" up to 15"
Class 158	Veteran, 6 years and older, 10 up to 12 ½"

Class 160	Seniors, 9 years and older, 10 up 12 ½"
Class 161	Seniors, 9 years and older, 12 ½ up to 15"

DIVISION K - YOUTH

Exhibitors must compete in a minimum of Youth Handling and Youth Go-to-Ground to qualify for the Youth High Score and Reserve. A tie will be broken with the final decision made by a Conformation Judge other than the Judge of the day. The tiebreaker takes place in the conformation ring and is determined at the Judge's discretion by the exhibitor's handling/presentation of his/her terrier, by the answers to the Judge's questions, or by a combination of the two.

- Class 162 **Child Handler.** Open to any youth aged 5 through 9, handling a Jack Russell Terrier, six months of age or older. This class is offered as an introductory experience in handling and learning about the Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on child's ability to present his/her dog and beginning knowledge of the Jack Russell. Quality of the dog NOT to be considered.
- Class 163 **Youth Handler.** Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling an adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of the Jack Russell Terrier. Quality of the dog NOT to be considered.
- Class 164 **Youth Working Judge's Choice.** Open to any youth handler aged 10-16 handling an adult JRT. Judged on the youth's knowledge of hunting and the working terrier and ability to answer questions presented by a JRTCA Working Judge; no terrier to accompany handler in class.
- Class 165 **Youth Go-to-Ground.** Open to any youth aged 10 through 16 handling an adult JRT. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of Go-to-Ground. To be run through the 10-foot Novice liner; time not to be considered.
- Class 166 **YOUTH Handler High Score and Reserve**Awarded to the highest scoring youth and runner-up in classes 152 and 156. The points are awarded as follows: 1st = 8 points; 2nd = 6 points; 3rd = 5 points; 4th = 4 points; 5th = 3 points; 6th = 2 points; and participation = 1 point.
